

MIKE ANGLIN'S RECORD

Dear Neighbor,

Since you elected me in November of 2007, I have worked hard to represent you. It has been a great honor for me to serve as a Council member from the Fifth Ward. My top priority has been to find ways to make city government more responsive to the needs of citizens instead of the needs of developers and big business. In the twenty months I have acted as your representative, I have worked with many citizen groups. These include neighborhood groups opposing oversized developments on South Maple and South Fifth Avenue, residents of the Virginia Park area concerned with city tree removal policies, residents of the Old West Side concerned with pedestrian safety, and groups advocating for a full-scale Greenway, including stronger floodplain regulations to protect the environmentally fragile Allen Creek watershed.

We have not won all the battles, but the voices of citizens are beginning to be heard. Many more groups and individual citizens are going to Council caucus meetings, which are now being covered by the Ann Arbor Chronicle (annarborchronicle.com). Caucus is an informal meeting between Council and the public and held in Council Chambers at 7:00 pm on Sunday evenings prior to Council meetings which are held on Mondays.

Grossly inaccurate statements about my attendance record have been made. I want to set the record straight. During my twenty months on council, I have missed only one out of forty-one Council meetings. No Council member who has served this entire twenty-month period has a better Council attendance record. My attendance record for caucus meetings is also second to none-- thirty-six out of thirty-seven meetings. In addition to Council meetings, each month there are between three and four other meetings for Council committees and work sessions. I have attended 75% of those meetings. Unfortunately, family and other obligations have prevented me from attending all of them.
